



## POOL RULES - MAY 2026

Please read and follow the pool/clubhouse rules so all Courtyard residents can enjoy the pool this summer. The Courtyard swimming pool is private and reserved for the use of members and their guests only. We expect calm, quiet and civil behavior at this facility. All Association rules apply to Unit Owners and anyone in their employ, as well as tenants, children and guests.

- **IMPORTANT** — When entering the pool area from the clubhouse, you must open the door and then press the alarm mute or "shunt" button — it is on the white alarm box mounted right on the door. This is a safety system so children cannot wander in to the pool area unattended. If you do not press this button, the alarm will go off and disrupt the residents.
- The pool will open at 9am and close at 9pm.
- The maximum number of pool users at any time is FOUR per household. Therefore, since **there must be at least one unit owner in attendance with their guests**, the maximum number of guests would be THREE.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult and noise is to be kept at a minimum. No diving, running, rough play, loud music or foul language is allowed. No children of diaper-wearing age will be allowed in the pool (although dipping their feet while being held by an adult is permitted).
- Per State law, any person with infections, open sores or communicable diseases will not be allowed in the pool. No spitting, blowing of nose, band aids (wound coverages) are allowed in the pool and all persons must shower before entering the pool. Proper swimming attire is required (no cut-off jeans, etc.).
- The pool water will be tested/sampled daily per State regulations and the pool vendor will be onsite twice a week to clean the pool and also test the levels.
- **There is no lifeguard on duty.** Persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Failure to comply with the pool rules will result in suspension of pool access for 15 days.
